Minutes of Morrow Tree Board Meeting Oct 20, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 3:04pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag
Roll was called and SueAnn Nelson, Agnes McIntosh, and Barbara Thompson were present.

Minutes of the Sept 15 meeting were approved

Old business was discussed: Trees as discussed in the Sept meeting have not yet arrived.

New Business

SueAnn said that she is studying to be an arborist, and that effort will take several years.

SueAnn suggested that Flat Rock would make a good community project, and put a motion on the floor to clean up Flat Rock, plant shrubs. And also to clean up honeysuckle, as Urban Forester is against honeysuckle. We could possibly involve Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts and we would supervise. Motion was tabled for further study.

SueAnn stated a desire to involve the whole community in a contest, and ask Council to offer an award for biggest trees. Motion was made to set up something on the Village Website for the oldest and largest trees and possibly describe something special about them. The motion failed.

Barbara suggested the evergreen tree at the front of the Church of the Nazarene on First Street.

SueAnn stated that the Tree Board might earn an award for involvement with The Woodlands.

SueAnn moved to adjourn and Agnes seconded the motion. Meeting was adjourned by unanimous vote.
