- 1. We need an inventory of all the trees in Morrow that are visible from the street. Could this be a community service project for high school students? This will be recommended to Council.
 - 2. Fertilizer is not good for trees.
 - 3. Overwatering drowns trees and shrubs
 - 4. Trees breathe through their roots.
 - 5. Clay is the best base for trees because of its nutrients.
 - 6. Plant what grows naturally in the area.
